Paul Bryan Sandstrom (1925 – 2011) 85, passed away Thursday, April 21, 2011. Funeral: 2 p.m. Tuesday at St. Luke United Methodist Church, with the Rev. Tom Connolly, the Rev. Dr. Jeff May and the Rev. Dr. Lamar Smith officiating. Interment: Mount Olivet Cemetery. Visitation: 5:30 to 8 p.m. Monday at Mount Olivet Funeral Home. Paul was born Aug. 19, 1925, in the parsonage of St. John's United Methodist Church in Georgetown to the Rev. J.H. Sandstrom, who was born in Sweden, and Edith Bragg Sandstrom, who was born in Keller. Paul graduated from Keller High School and Texas Wesleyan College. In his senior year at Texas Wesleyan, he was selected by his professors to be in "Who's Who in American Colleges and Universities" of those most likely to succeed in their chosen profession. He served on the board and was a past president of the Texas Wesleyan Alumni Association. Paul served in the U.S. Army during World War II and received two Bronze Stars for service on Luzon in the Philippines. Paul served with the 158th Regimental combat team, which was among the first troops to occupy Japan after its surrender. An agent for Southwestern Life Insurance Co. for the past 40 years, Paul also represented the Texas Life and Great American Life Insurance companies. A life member of the Million Dollar Round Table and the Texas Leaders Round Table, he was a past president of the Fort Worth Association of Life Underwriters, on the board of the Texas Association of Life Underwriters and served as chairman of the official board of the St. Luke United Methodist Church, president of the Methodist Men, superintendent of the Sunday school, usher and greeter. Paul was a member of the Haltom City Masonic Lodge #1331, Moslah Shrine, a 32nd-degree Scottish Rite Mason, and a member of the Bedouins. He helped organize and served on the board of the Northeast National Bank. Paul also served on the board of Harris Hospital as a representative of the Central Texas Conference of the Methodist Church for three years. Paul was preceded in death by his parents; the mother of his children, Elsie Grant Sandstrom, in 1978; son, Mark W. Sandstrom; and brother, J.R. Sandstrom. Survivors: Wife, Tommie Ann Sandstrom; son, Scott Grant Sandstrom of Fort Worth; daughters, Paulette S. Berl of Fort Worth and Susan S. Dyer of Austin; grandchildren, Charity, Alicia, Taylor, Elise, Christina, Leilah, Emily, Travis, Karin and James Bryan; six great-grandchildren; stepdaughters, Diane Sullivan and Leigh Liverman; stepson, Bo Gaston; stepgrandchildren, Jodi, Cade and Casey; and a host of nieces, nephews, friends and associates.

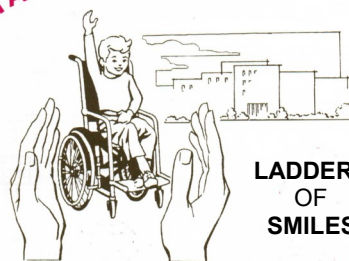
